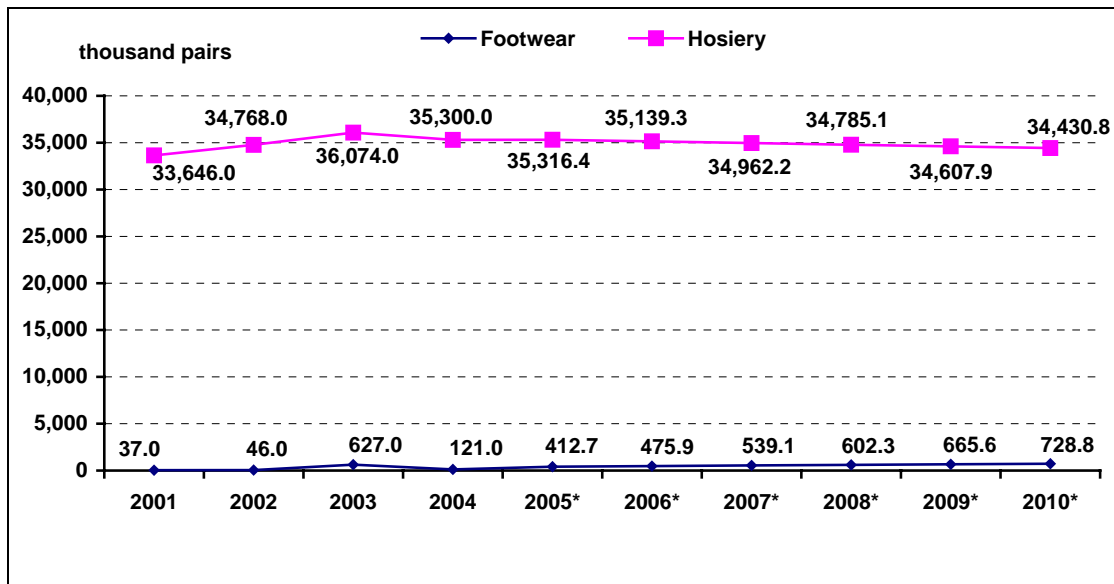

**Chart 2-1-4. Footwear and Hosiery Forecasts in the Smolensk Region, 2001-2010**



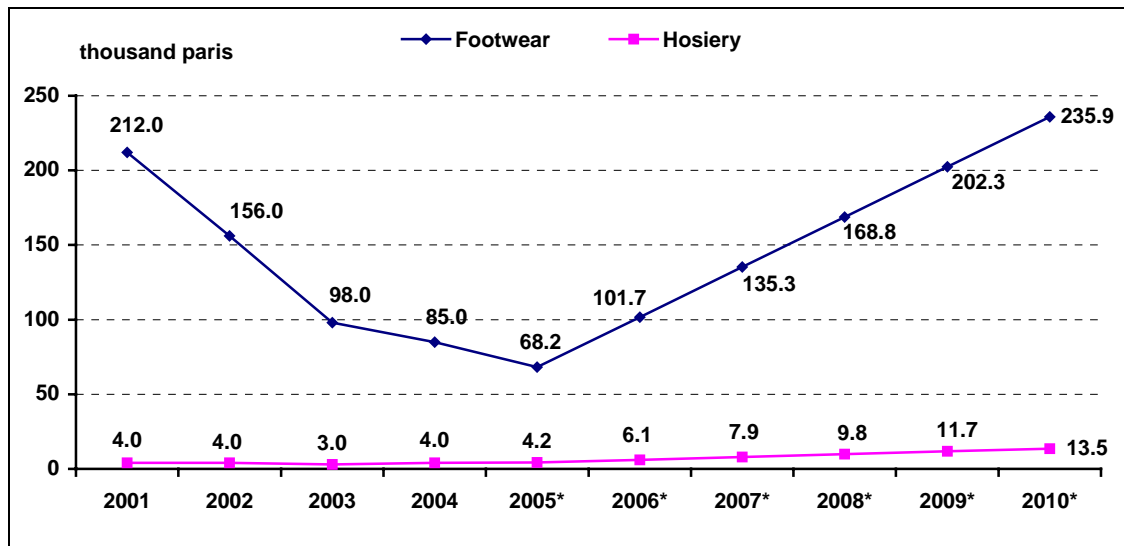

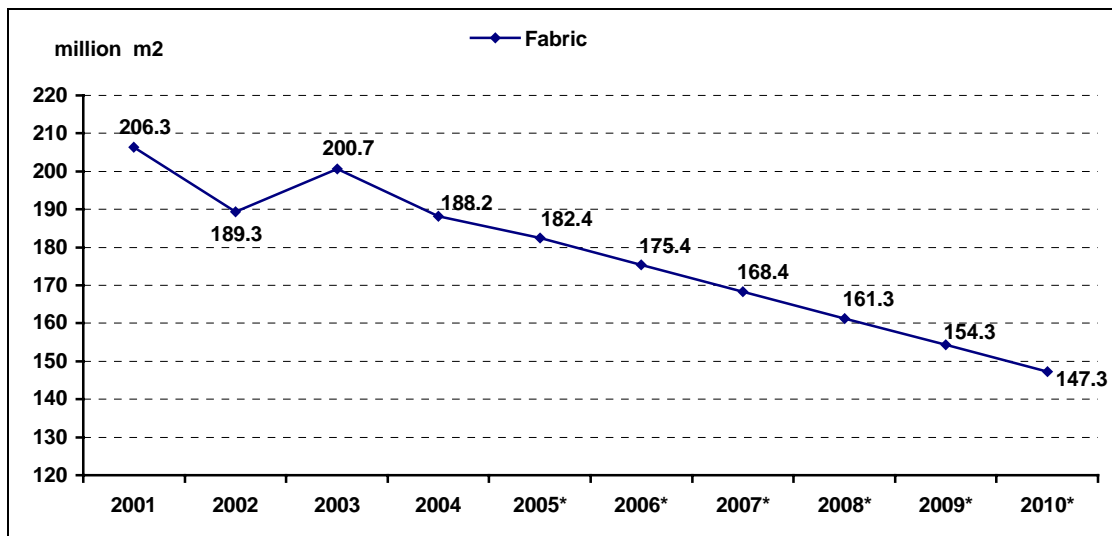

## **Tax System**

### ***General***

Russia's tax system has undergone major changes since the country first began laying the basis of a modern tax system back in 1991. January 1, 1999, marked the introduction of Part 1 of the RF Tax Code, which established the general principles, rules and procedures to be followed by the tax authorities and taxpayers.

Most of sections of Part 2 of the RF Tax Code have already taken effect. The chapters on value added tax, excise tax, personal income tax and the unified social tax took effect on January 1, 2001. The chapters on profit tax and mineral resource extraction tax took effect on January 1, 2002. The section of the RF Tax Code governing special tax regimes took effect on January 1, 2003. This section provides for a simplified tax regime, a unified tax on imputed income for certain types of activity, a unified agricultural tax, taxation when implementing a production sharing agreement, and includes a section governing local taxation procedures. The chapters on the license fee on animal world members, charge on water biological resources, as well as a new edition of the chapter on the unified agricultural tax took effect on January 1, 2004. And, finally, the chapters on levy of state duty, a land tax, and a water tax took effect on January 1, 2005.

Another positive result of the evolution of Russia's tax system has been the recognition of Russia's international tax responsibilities by the Russian tax authorities and the expansion of the number of double taxation avoidance treaties signed by Russia. Russia is currently party to 68 such treaties, including those concluded by the former Soviet Union and honored by the Russian Federation. A further 15 are at various stages of the negotiations and ratification process.

In 2003–2005, Russia's State Duma adopted a number of new laws aimed at further improving the country's tax system and reducing the overall tax burden, including a liberalized tax regime for small enterprises, reduction of the profit tax, value added tax, and unified social tax rates, and improvement of the simplified tax system. The year of 2004 also saw an end of the opposition between Ministry of Taxes and Duties of the Russian Federation and Ministry of Finance of the Russian Federation on the subject of tax regulations and accounting. The RF President's Decree of March 9, 2004, No. 314 converted the Ministry of Taxes and Duties of the Russian Federation into the Federal Tax Service (FTS) under the Ministry of Finance of the Russian Federation with the latter assigned the functions of regulating and interpreting the tax matters in the Russian Federation.

### ***Tax System Structure***

The structure of Russia's tax system provides for tax revenues for three budgetary levels: federal, regional, and local. Legislation introducing, amending and abolishing taxes, setting rates and providing exemptions is enacted at the federal level. With respect to regional and local taxes, however, regional and local governments have the power to establish rates within the limits provided by federal law, to establish settlement procedures and deadlines, to determine reporting procedures, and to grant exemptions to certain categories of taxpayers.

The following is a summary of the major taxes and levies payable by corporations and individuals in the Russian Federation.
